

PULASKI WOODMAN FULLER

Places and Career – By Date

- 1823 – Born Boston, MA – Father (Sumner) was b. 1799, Newton, MA
- 1823 – Baptized at the Old South Church, Boston
- 1830 – South Boston, Father was a Chandler in South Boston, Census, Ward 12
- 1832 ~ Likely moved to Andover with Family
- 1834 ~ May have moved to Charleston SC with parents
- 1840 – June 1, Census, Andover, MA mother is head of household as father had died in SC
- 1842 – Married – 8 Dec., 1842, Barnard, Windsor Co., VT. to Zilpha Perkins BUCKMAN
- 1847 – Worked in Hamilton Print Works (print on material), Lowell, MA
- 1849 - Colporteur (peddler of religious material), Lowell, MA
- 1850 – Census – Labourer in Leominster Mass.
- 1853 - Hostler (stableman – to take care of horses), Lowell, MA
- 1855 – Lowell, MA + Fall River, MA
- 1856 – Fall River, MA
- 1858 – Ohio (Cincinnati)
- 1860-61 Baptist Minister in Milford, Hamilton Township, Ohio, 1860 Census, Columbia, Ohio
- 1861-62 Pastor in the Civil War – joined June 18, 1861 at Fort Dennison, Min. (officially served 3yrs and 3 months. (was treated in the hospital and when released – thought that he could go home as he had been wounded and then released from the hospital, but he was apprehended in Vershire for being AWOL – returned to army and stood trial – cleared of all charges.)
- 1863-65 He served 1st Baptist Church Vershire, Vermont
- 1865-68 Pastor of Baptist Church Groton, Calidonia Co.
- 1870-71 Pastor of Baptist Church in North Troy, Vermont
- 1871- Pastor of Baptist Church in Bramtre [Braintree] , Vermont starting June 1871 (P.O. Address Randolph)
- 1872-75 October, 1872 appointed as Missionary Pastor by the Baptist Home Mission Society of New York City to Long Prairie, Todd Co. and Kandiyohi, Kandiyohi Co., Min.
- 1876 – Missionary Pastor in Maple Hill, Min. (PO Box was Long Prairie)
- 1878-79 – Pastor in Lake Amelia Church (PO Box was Long Prairie)
- 1884-86 - Pastor in Kasson, Dodge Co., Min.
- 1886 – Pastor Money Creek, Houston Co., Min.
- 1886 – “because of health, I resigned and moved to St. Paul in Oct. 1886 and am a member of the 1st Baptist church with Rev. W.H. Butrick as Pastor.”
- 1888 – Dec. 28, PW applied for Invalid Pension...
- 1897 - died (age 73) in and is buried at the Baptist Cemetery in Long Prairie, Min.
