

FULLER COAL MINE CARBON, ALBERTA, CANADA

CARBON COAL MINE #749

This coal mine underlies the land designated as 15-11-29-23W4 which was owned at one time by Charles Woodman FULLER.

The following extract from ERCB Report ST45 “Coal Mine Atlas Historical Owners of Mines in Alberta” shows ownership over time of this mine till abandonment.

There are several photos which show the main entrance to the mine and may have been taken after the Fuller’s owned it. During their tenure they likely used a simple cable winch system to haul coal up the hill and dump it into wagons for transport. It was only later that a rail spur was run to the mine and it was expanded in a more thorough fashion. The photographs show this later development.
